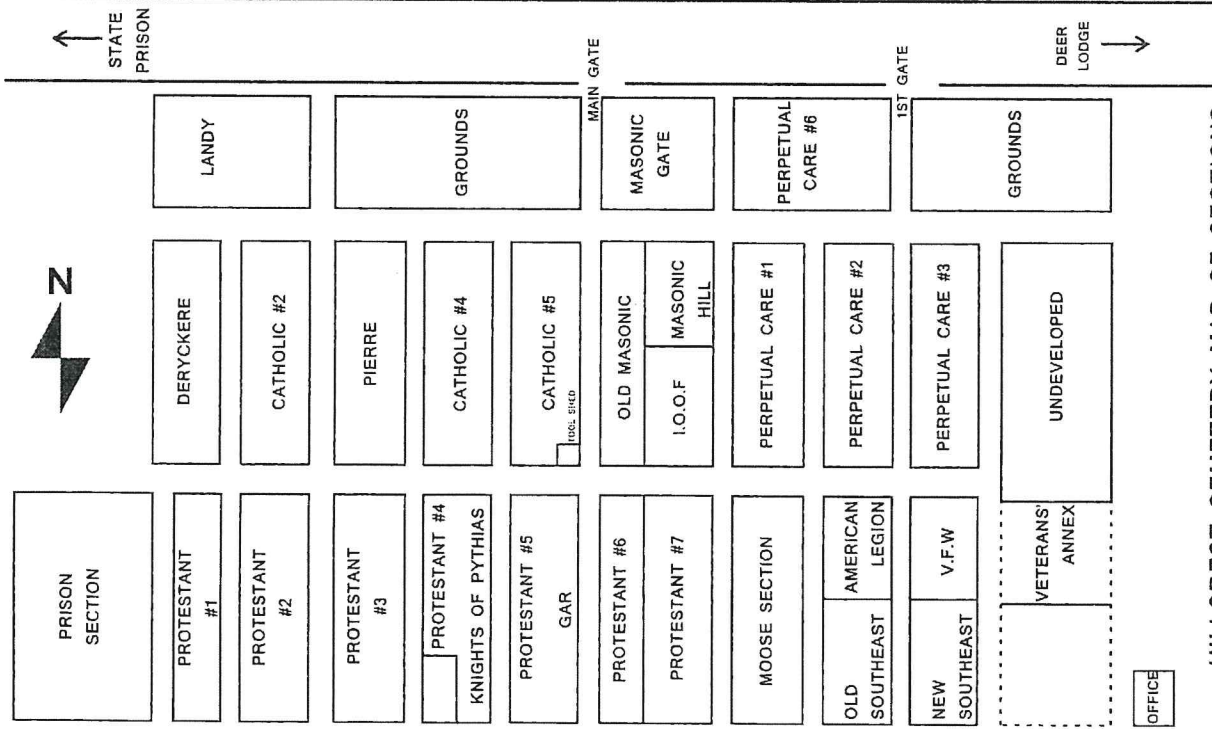
Hillcrest Cemetery

Directions to Hillcrest Cemetery:

From Westbound, exit to Deer Lodge, turn left at stop light, corner of Main St. and Milwaukee Ave.

From Eastbound, exit to Deer Lodge, turn right at stop light, corner of Main St. and Milwaukee Ave.

Follow Milwaukee out of town, the cemetery will be located on the left side of the road.

Memorial Day Exceptions to Decorations— Flowers and decorations may be stuck into the ground and placed on the grass around monuments for Memorial Day. These items shall be removed by the owner no later than 10 days after Memorial Day. If not removed after ten days, the City will dispose of all such items.

Memorial trees, shrubberies, benches, etc. may be donated and placed in the cemetery. The location must be agreed upon by the City and the donor. Placement will be executed by the City.

Fees are due 30 days from day of service for burials.
 Fees for monuments settings are due immediately after setting completion.

Resolution No. 1188, passed by City Council April 2, 2012.

All full and cremation burials will be conducted by the City, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. The City shall be given a minimum of 48 hours notice before a burial.

All caskets require a vault and all cremations require an urn or vault.

Preparation of monument bases and setting of monuments will be installed by the City. Monuments may be of granite or bronze, or any combination of granite and bronze. Headstone monuments must be no more than six inches in height, may be any width, length or number, but must fit entirely on the monument base, which will be no larger than 38 inches by 22 inches (38"x22"). Flat monuments will be set flush with the ground, and may be no larger than 32"x16", the City making the final decision as to the placement.

All decorations must sit on, or hang above the concrete monument base. Nothing shall extend beyond the base. Nothing shall be stuck into, planted or placed on the ground surrounding the concrete base. This facilitates mowing and weeding around the graves. No glass, porcelain or breakable decorations are allowed. The placement and removal of all flower boxes is the responsibility of the owner. Silk flowers, non-perishable and non-breakable decorations, placed as directed above, may remain year round. Such decorations may be removed at the City's discretion, if they deteriorate or become a hazard.

Flowers and Decorations for Graveside Service- Flowers and decorations may be stuck into the ground and placed on the grass during the graveside service. These items shall be removed by the owner no later than 24 hours after the graveside service. If not removed after 24 hours, the City will dispose of all such items. Exceptions are those that hang above or are in flower pots or boxes.
