

Notice for Public Comment of Environmental Review for a Grant Application by the City of Deer Lodge to the Montana Historic Preservation Grant Program

The City of Deer Lodge will take public statements for the purpose of obtaining comments regarding the environmental review for the proposed City Hall maintenance project that will stabilize and renovate the exterior structure of the structure as well as fund the completion of a Preliminary Architectural Report for future improvements to the interior of City Hall. The public comment session will occur during the City Council meeting on February 22, 2022 at 6PM in the Powell County Community Center, 416 Cottonwood Avenue.

At the public hearing the proposed project will be explained, including the purpose and proposed area of the project, activities, budget, sources of funding, any costs that may result for local citizens because of the project, and a decision will be made on the environmental assessment. All interested persons will be given the opportunity to ask questions and express opinions regarding the proposed project and any environmental impacts.
