- a. Main Street Painting – Jordan

Jordan presented ideas and asked suggestions from committee of best way to go about the process. Reach out to Ace & R&C for assistance to purchase paint at wholesale. Create an application with business owner information, approximate dimensions of building, what colors that business owners want which should be same colors that currently exists , and the compacity to get your business painted within three months. Historic registrar building, Historic Preservation will need to be involved with paint choice to stay in line with the proper historic colors.
